A good sized crowd showed up at the SVCA Monday night September 19 to resume our monthly gatherings and to see a presentation from John Ryan about the Alligator Creek watershed. One of the highlights was learning about the wonderful walkways available along the upper creek near Woodmere Park. Ryan again praised the work of SVCA's Water Quality Task Force and said they are a model of community participation and action. Ryan added that natural waterways are being reclaimed all over the world by citizen activists.

We learned about all the County's efforts on local waterways and envi-

ronments and about the Neighborhood Environmental Stewardship Teams — called NEST — which involves groups forming throughout the County.

After a vigorous Q&A, everyone enjoyed the coffee and desserts.

**Seasons & Serendipity Strolls** continue on the second and fourth Fridays each month – that's October 14 and 28 - at 8:00am. Horse mint spires are really striking now. Huge fields of blooms mixed with autumn grasses sway in the breeze. Bring binoculars if you want to spot birds, including herons, egrets, ospreys, red-bellied woodpeckers and scrub- jays.

Our next **Demonstration Garden Tour**, led by Master Gardeners, is on Thursday, October 6 at 9:00am. Tours continue through 2016 on the first Thursday of each month. The 'Edibles' raised bed is producing some interesting items – including Italian figs!

#### Don't miss this one!

The Full Moon will be celebrated on Saturday, October 15. Weather permitting, we'll have a telescope set up to better see the moon's topography, including many named craters and valleys. Night-blooming moon flowers may be opening and night sounds and critters are always fun on the trails after dark.



Loopíng Programs

Quite a few years back at Venice Isle's clubhouse, looping equipment was installed. We have worked with this looping equipment company over the years to provide education for the hearing aid wearers. It was during this event that I bumped into my first awareness of under-programmed t-coil settings. (T-coil is the program setting to receive the looping transmission.)

A couple came up to me and mentioned that they weren't hearing much different whether they put on the t-coil setting or put it on the first program of their hearing aids. They wondered what the purpose of the looping equipment was if there wasn't much difference.

You should hear whatever is being broadcasted much cleaner, crisper and without distortion. There should be a noticeable difference when hearing the broadcast sounds without t-coil to hearing with t-coil.

I asked if they had the t-coil programmed. They weren't sure. I suggested they come into my office to have the t-coil program reviewed. They came in and sure enough their t-coil was active and under programmed. This is a problem I run into too often. While many aids have the technology to connect to t-coil, many are not correctly programmed to give the listener clarity.

I was able to help this couple by using the looping equipment in my office to adjust his program settings which enabled him to hear the crisper sounds that are provided through the looping equipment both at his clubhouse and when he went to the Venice Theatre.

If you want to know if your hearing aids can connect to t-coil or feel like you're not getting clarity from the program, I invite you to stop by my office for a checkup.

## Beach Trust News

This is an exciting time for the SVBET as our Ferry House Renovations and Ferry repairs are underway! Monday, September 26, was the big day! The Ferry house is now officially a construction site. Our ferry has left for repairs – *there she is at right, on her way* — and life as we know it has been halted for several weeks.

The cap, which is the concrete around the edge of the floor, will be the first thing to be replaced. (You may have noticed the crumbling when you got on the ferry.) Looking up, you may have noticed the spall. That is the chipping and crumbling on the ceiling that will be removed and replaced. The counter weights for the gangway will be reengineered. We will have new fencing, new railings and an epoxy floor. It should be looking quite spiffy! We are fortunate to have a structure that was built by the Army Corps of Engineers as it was constructed to last-- but five decades and 30,000 plus riders a year does take its toll....



You may have noticed the new trailer for the ferry. This is custom fitted to our boat and was used to transport her for repairs while the ferry house renovations are being undertaken. The trailer will also be used for Coast Guard inspections and as part of our hurricane safety procedure.

I am sure that many of us have survived home repairs and remodeling. It is never a fun experience. BUT when we get to enjoy the benefits of the inconvenience for years to come, it is worth it. Our contractors are cognizant of how much our ferry and beach are loved by the community. They are coordinating their efforts to have our ferry house completed and our ferry running as quickly as possible. Your understanding and patience during this time are greatly appreciated.





