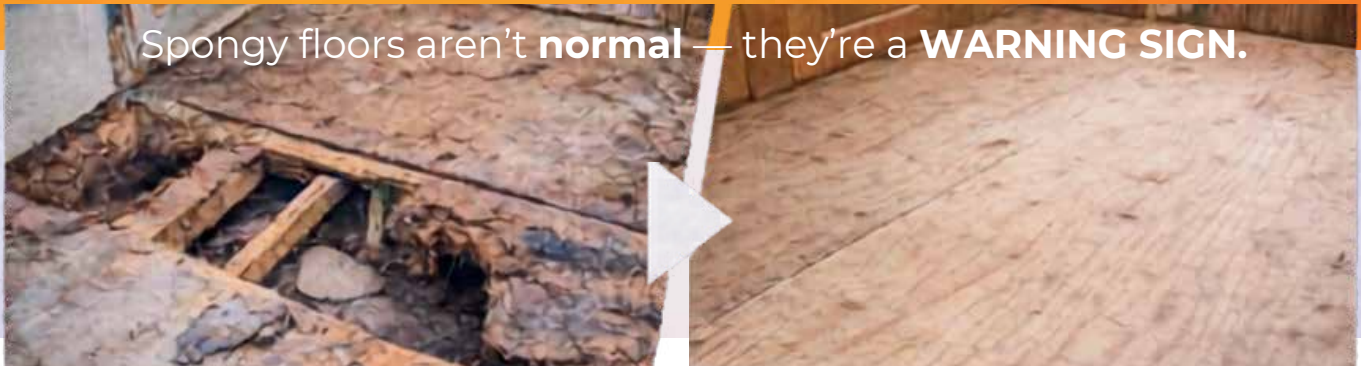

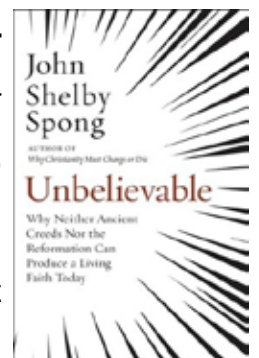

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JULY FUN FACTS

July is the seventh month of the year, named after Julius Caesar, and is rich in history, holidays, and summer traditions.

Origins and Calendar Facts

July was originally called **Quintilis** in the Roman calendar, as it was the fifth month before calendar reforms. It was renamed **July** in honor of **Julius Caesar**, who was born in this month and reformed the Roman calendar to the Julian system. It has **31 days**, making it one of the longer months of the year. In the **Northern Hemisphere**, July is the warmest month and part of summer, while in the **Southern Hemisphere**, it is the coldest month, falling in winter.

Holidays and Observances

- **Independence Day (USA):** July 4th, commemorating the Declaration of Independence in 1776.
- **Canada Day:** July 1st, celebrating the confederation of Canada in 1867.
- **Bastille Day (France):** July 14th, marking the start of the French Revolution in 1789.
- **National Ice Cream Month:** Celebrated in the United States throughout July.
- **Tour de France:** The famous cycling race typically begins in July.

Zodiac and Symbols

- **Zodiac Signs:** Cancer (June 21 – July 22) and Leo (July 23 – August 22), influencing personality traits and astrological traditions.
- **Birthstone:** Ruby, symbolizing love and passion.

Dozens of multiple-colored roses were distributed to all the guests.

Meyer outlined several upcoming Homeowners' events including the first-ever July 25 Christmas in July Craft Fair. She said that 33 vendors from CVP and all around the area have now paid for the event. That free event is open to the general public.

The budget for Saturday's Brunch & Blossoms event featured \$280 spent, and a \$143.34 profit turned over to Board Treasurer Terraciano.

Permitted Items: small shrubs, bushes and plants. Leaf and grass trimmings. Bundled sticks no longer than 3.5 feet. Small organic materials.

Items NOT Permitted: home renovation materials, construction debris, electronics, carpet, tile, bricks, windows, doors, furniture, appliances or household garbage.

If you are unsure whether an item is allowed, please contact the management office at before placing it in the dumpster. Residents who are in violation will be subject to penalties.
