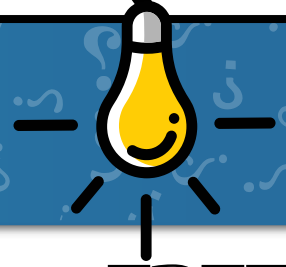

During the month of May, I would like to send a friendly reminder of some rules & regulations of the community:

- Late fees are assessed at the time your **correct payment is received** by the office, not when you mailed it or dropped off the incorrect amount.

- All tenants must be registered with the office if staying for more than 14 consecutive days
- The only signs permitted at your homesite are one "for sale" sign measuring 9" x 13" if applicable. No other signs are allowed to be displayed in your window(s) or on your lawns
- If you have guest visiting, you must be present with them while they are using the amenities (pool, clubhouse, etc.)
- **NO outside storage** is permitted throughout the community. This includes your carport and the sides/back of your home
- All homes should be clear of any dirt and/or mold on all four (4) sides, including skirting

**Family Scams**

Scammers are good at **pretending to be someone that they're not**. They try to trick you into thinking **a loved one is in trouble**.

Once the scammer makes you think they're your grandson and in trouble, they pressure you to quickly send them money. **But it's all a scam.**

Your family member was never in trouble.

- The scammer will say it's **urgent** and that you're the only one who can help.
- The scammer might tell you it's **important to keep it secret**. They don't want you talking to other family members and friends and realizing it's a scam.
- The scammers will **play with your emotions**. They're counting on you to act quickly to help your family or friend. And they're counting on you to pay without stopping to check out whether there's really an emergency. If you get a call like this, you can be sure this is a scam.

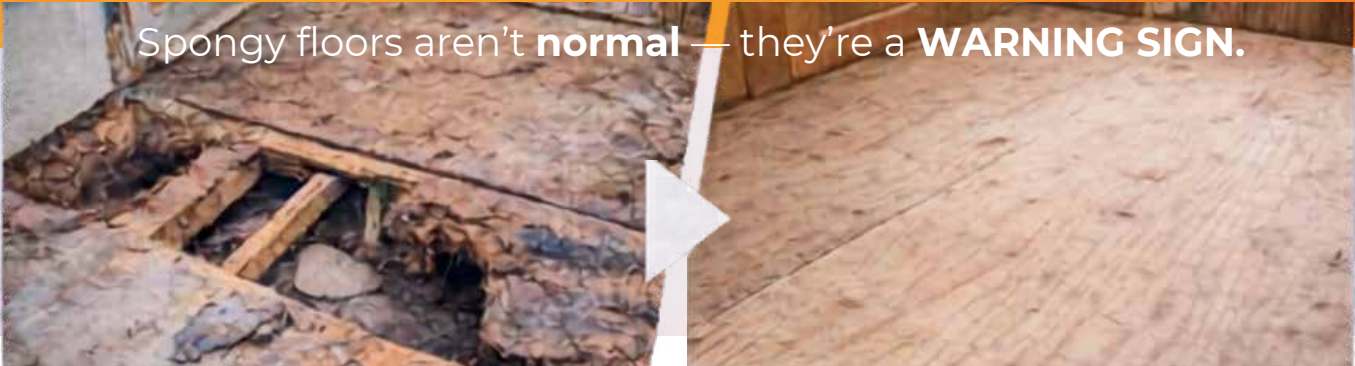

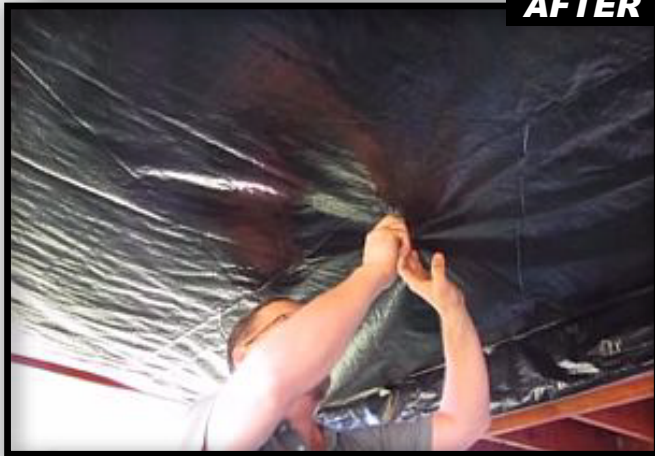
