Clubhouse Calendar Transition



This is to inform you; the clubhouse calendar has recently been transitioned to the HOA for management. The goal of this change is to ensure that scheduling of the clubhouse remains **fair, organized, and accessible**

to all residents and groups within our community.

We are fortunate to have many active clubs and activities that help make Sundance such a vibrant place to live, and the HOA appreciates the time and dedication each of you gives to keeping these activities going.

In order to establish a clear and consistent scheduling system, the HOA will be rebuilding the clubhouse calendar and asking all clubs and recurring activities to submit a **Recurring Activity Request Form**.

Because our community experiences a significant increase in residents during the winter months, the new calendar structure will reflect **two scheduling seasons**:

Snowbird Season (October – April)

During these months there is greater demand for the clubhouse. Scheduling may require additional flexibility so that a variety of activities and community events can be accommodated.

Summer Season (May – September)

During the summer months the community is smaller, and clubs will typically be able to maintain a more consistent recurring schedule.

Our goal is not to disrupt the traditions of our existing clubs, but rather to create a scheduling system that allows both long-standing activities and new opportunities to coexist fairly.

There will be a meeting on **April 6, 2026, at 5:00 pm** in the clubhouse where additional information and reservation request forms will be distributed so that we can begin organizing the new calendar. **The calendar reset will begin on May 1, 2026.**

Thank you again for everything you do to help make Sundance such an active and welcoming community.

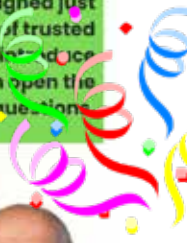

Rules for Subletting your home:

- Unless the home is subleased upon prior written permission of Community Management, the principal resident of each home in the Community must be its legal owner. Except as expressly provided by applicable Florida law, no one other than those executing the Rental Agreement shall be allowed to reside upon the lot set forth in the Rental Agreement without prior written consent from Community Management.
- The total number of occupants in the sublet home is limited to (2) two persons and all occupants must be at least (55) fifty-five years of age.
- No more than (2) two guests of a renter at one time for a stay of not more than (15) fifteen consecutive days per (12) twelve-month period is permitted.
- A homeowner may sublet their home no more than (3) three times in a (12) twelve-month period to run from beginning of the subletting period through (12) twelve months thereafter.

Reminders:

- Please, please, please do not feed the feral cats. We need to stop the infestation and we are dwindling down on the resources to aid the park in the removal of the cats.

Thank you for your patience as we continue to recover from the gate accident and the deep freeze. We are hard at work trying to restore the community to its original luster!



Clubhouse Courtesy Reminder

To ensure the clubhouse remains clean and ready for all residents to enjoy, anyone using the facility for informal gatherings (coffee groups, cards, snacks, etc.) is responsible for basic light clean-up after their activity.

Light clean-up includes:

- Dry sweeping the floor
- Spot mopping any spills
- Wipe down tables or surfaces used
- Remove trash and personal items

The park has professional cleaners who come twice a week for full cleaning. As long as we all help with light clean-up after use, a full sweep and mop will not be necessary after every activity.

Thank you for your cooperation and for helping keep our shared spaces in good condition.

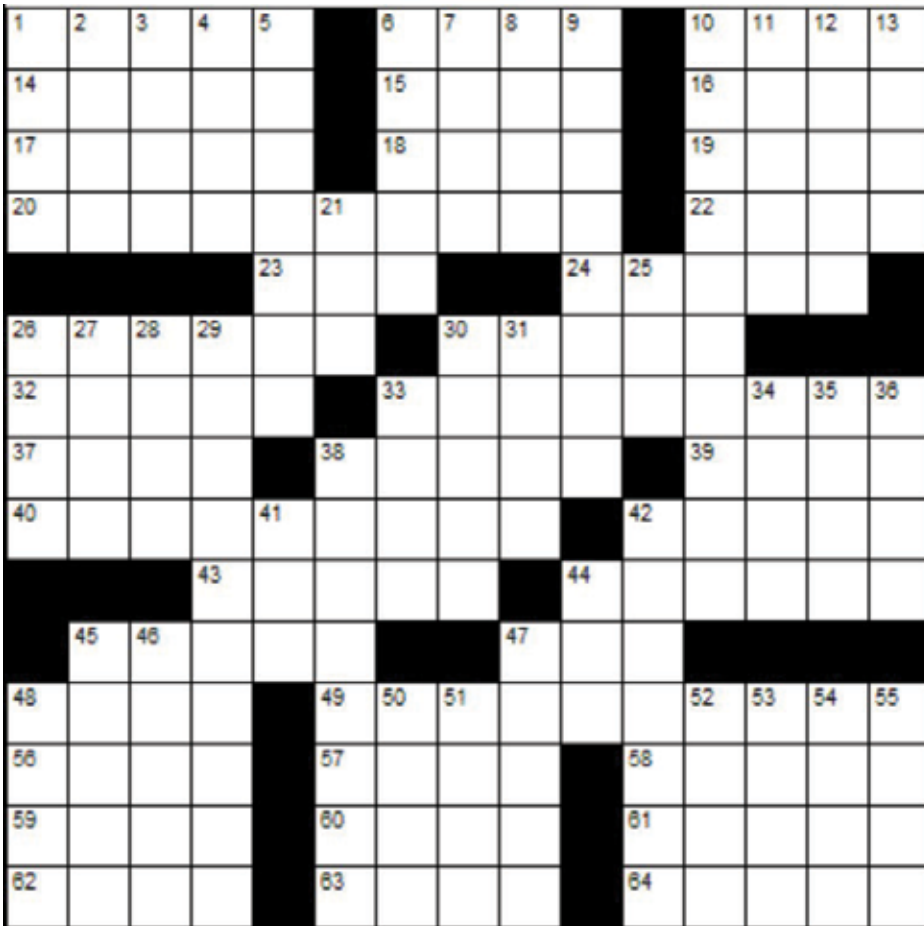
