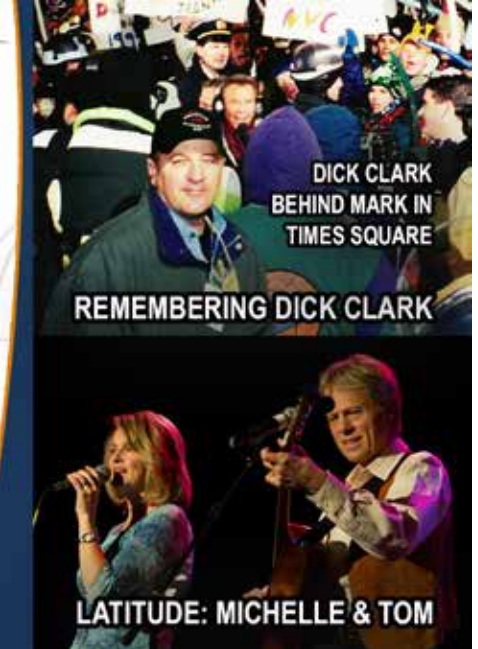

The Cypress Falls Safety Team Monthly Update - October/2022



Many of you have been concerned regarding the gate situation and the incidents of trespassing that have occurred recently during June, July, and August. First a brief caution, if your source of information is

other than the management office, I would encourage you to validate the information before getting overly aggravated by the information. There have been multiply occurrences where the information has not been true or valid, and the author has made statements that were not accurate. The Safety Team personnel have had great cooperation from North Port P.D., and numerous cases have resulted in citations.

It is important to note that the Transition Team's leadership and our HOA representative have in fact been in close communications with Pulte regarding the gate issue. Pulte has agreed to remedy the situation before our upcoming turnover. In addition, we all should be aware that even when the gates were working, we had trespassing issues, Cypress Falls is not a secure facility since gaining entrance to our complex can be achieved through multiple ways.

MONTHLY TIP: The Safety Team is comprised of volunteers who do not patrol every night; the Team is not the police and so if you see something suspicious each resident should call North Port Police to report it. Examples of incidents worth reporting:

- Suspicious vehicles parked on the street or in unusual location, whether occupied or not.
- Loud noises coming from the pool area after closing or hours of darkness.
- People fishing in the ponds, as most are marked "No Fishing or Trespassing."
- Any solicitors during daylight hours should be reported to the office.
- Vehicles that tailgate you or another vehicle to get through a gate.

The safety team has lost a few of our members for various reasons, including having moved, so if you are interested in joining, we would welcome anyone who would like to join, either email me at phil.ludos@gmail.com or give me a call at 941-200-5491. It requires just 1-2 nights a month and is a service that most of our residents really appreciate.

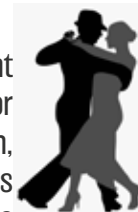
