




The August 8th Ladies Lunch Bunch will be held at "Linger Lodge" in Bradenton and hosted by Cindy BonDurant.

The Lodge is known for its authentic Old Florida charm and cozy riverside atmosphere. Located right on the river, Linger Lodge is surrounded by nature, home to some beautifully authentic Floridan vistas and no shortage of alligators, turtles, and other wildlife.


It is a quirky yet charming restaurant with a scenic view of the Braden River.

World premiere set for
Mark Twain-inspired 'Original Sin'



Whether you consider yourself a Creationist or an Evolutionist – or something in between – you are likely to enjoy the world premiere of "Original Sin." The new comedy will be presented in cooperation with Treefort Productions Projects at their Studio Theatre this September.

As a boy, Alan Kitty became fascinated with the life and work of Mark Twain. Reading "The Adventures of Tom Sawyer" at age 8, he contemplated running away from home and living Tom's life. Instead, he has lived a Twain-inspired life.

His solo shows are based on Twain's writing and lectures, including the three-volume Autobiography published in 2010, 100 years after the author's death. For more than four decades, Kitty, a resident of Sarasota, has appeared on stage and in film as Twain more than 1,000 times. Most recently, he starred in what he calls 'a brutally brief biography' in "Mark Twain: They Told Me to Be Brief." The show was presented at both the Player's and Venice Theatres.

His latest project is a play adapted from "The Diaries of Adam & Eve: Translated by Mark Twain" (Fair Oaks Press, 1997). "Original Sin" is a satirical retelling of the Old Testament story about the first couple. The play doesn't presume to solve any disputes between Creationists and Evolutionists, and the playwright believes you won't leave the theatre saved from anything. But if laughter soothes, you will have gotten a dose.

As a veteran of 70 years on stage (he started very young) Kitty, 76, says he strives to pick topics that appeal to as wide an audience as possible. With "Original Sin" he hopes to appeal to believers and nonbelievers alike as he interprets Twain's retelling of Genesis.


Kitty co-stars in the two-person play with actress Jill Schroeder of Venice. It is being produced by The Mark Twain Society and directed by Alan Brasington.




