"Dear Residents,

It's a busy time in the community, and we appreciate everyone's cooperation as we work through several ongoing projects and issues. Please take a moment to read through the following updates and reminders:

Construction Notices

Blue Harbor Demolition

You've likely noticed the demolition work taking place on Blue Harbor. **Please remember this is an active CONSTRUCTION ZONE.**

For everyone's safety, only residents who live on Blue Harbor should be on this street during construction.

Seawall Progress – Eastlake Drive

Work on the seawall is progressing well, and we're

excited to see the finished product.

If you live near this construction area, **please do not park in the street** to help keep the area clear for equipment and workers.

Community Reminders

Storm & Hurricane Season Reminder

We're currently in storm and hurricane season. Please take time to secure and clean up around the outside of your home:

- Bring in or tie down outdoor furniture, grills, trash bins, and decorations
- Trim trees and remove weak branches
- Clear gutters and drains to prevent flooding
- Store all other loose items safely

Flying debris can cause serious damage to homes—and even people. Let's keep our neighborhoods safe. 

Stay safe and prepared!

Animal Policy

- **Do not feed animals outside.** This can attract unwanted wildlife and pose safety risks.
- **All pets must be on a leash** when outside your home.

Parking Rules

- **Parking on lawns is not permitted at any time.**
- When parking on the street, **do not block driveways or limit access** to neighboring homes. Please limit the time you are parking on the street so that you do not interfere with emergency vehicle needing to help someone quickly. **NO overnight parking is permitted.**
- Emergency vehicles and delivery trucks must be able to pass through the streets without obstruction.
- **All personal vehicles must fit completely within your carport.** Vehicles may not extend into the roadway.

Dress Code in Common Areas

As a reminder, proper attire is required throughout the community, walking to and from the pool, including while on golf carts.

Per the Prospectus:

"People using recreational areas must be properly dressed. Men shall wear shirts in the recreational area and all common areas. No mobile home owner, occupant or guest may wear bathing suits only in the recreational and common areas of the Park."

Speed Limit Reminder

Please observe the posted **15 MPH speed limit** at all times even while driving a golf cart. Thank you for your continued cooperation in keeping our community safe, respectful, and enjoyable for all.

HOA MEMBERSHIP

We started collecting dues for 2025 in December of 2024 and will continue through out the year. Remember, your membership starts January 1st and runs through December 31st no matter what month you join. **If you intend on voting in December, you must have a current membership by November 1st.**

Everyone asks, what do I get when I join the HOA? Well, you get a board of 7 people who are working together, and who will stand up for you against management. This same board keeps management on their toes by making sure they are complying with any and all city codes and ordinances. For ONLY \$20 a year, you join with your community to support the board and all it's efforts to offer activities for everyone, EVEN THE FREE ONES. \$2 of that fee goes straight into the legal fund. Your membership also gives you a vote and voice at members meetings. If you rent a unit in this community and join the HOA, you are considered an Associate Member, and entitled to all the same benefits as members but with no voting rights and also may not run for the Board.

Remember that there is strength in numbers. If you have not yet joined, your block captain will be happy to come over and collect from you. Or, contact me and I will make it happen.

Your HOA has a fiduciary responsibility to its membership.

Definition of fiduciary: *one who obligates himself or herself to act on behalf of another (as in managing money or property) and assumes a duty to act in good faith and with care, candor, and loyalty in fulfilling the obligation.*

Resolution steps to follow for ELS

- Step 1. Fill out comment/complaint form and take it to office and have them make a copy and initial and date it. If in 7 business days nothing has been done move to step 2.
- Step 2. Give a copy to the HOA board who will follow up with the office. If after 7 business days, if nothing is done move to step 3.
- Step 3. Send to Regional Manager Bill –reach out to the board for email address. If nothing is done in 7 days move to step 4.
- Step 4. Send to Regional VP Monsey – reach out to the board for email address. If nothing is done move to step 5.
- Step 5. Send to Senior VP Everett Butler—reach out to the board for email address.




Recommended Items to Include in a Basic Emergency Supply Kit

- Water and non-perishable food for several days
- Extra cell phone battery or charger
- Battery-powered or hand crank radio that can receive NOAA Weather Radio tone alerts and extra batteries
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- First aid kit
- Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- Whistle to signal for help
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation Non-sparking wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- Can opener (if kit contains canned food)
- Local maps

Additional Items to Consider Adding to an Emergency Supply Kit:

- Prescription medications and glasses
- Infant formula and diapers
- Pet food, water and supplies for your pet
- Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a portable waterproof container
- Cash and change
- Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or information from www.ready.gov
- Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person.
- Complete change of clothing including a long sleeved shirt, long pants and sturdy shoes.
- Fire Extinguisher Matches in a waterproof container
- Feminine supplies, personal hygiene items and hand sanitizer
- Mess kits, Paper cups, plates and disposable utensils, paper towels
- Paper and pencil Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children



If a unit is owned by more than one (1) person or is under lease, the person entitled to cast the vote for the unit shall be designated by a Certificate signed by all of the Record Owners if the unit and filed with the Secretary of the Association. In the event a unit is owned by a corporation the person entitled to cast the vote shall be designated by Certificate signed by the Officers of the corporation with the formalities required of a deed requiring 2 witnesses and a notary, and filed with the Secretary of the Association. Such Certificate shall be valid until it is revoked or superseded by a subsequent Certificate or until the ownership or the unit is changed or recorded. For purposes of this paragraph a purchaser under Contract for Sale, shall not be regarded as an owner. **The proper filing of a Certificate designating the person entitled to cast the vote of a unit is a condition precedent to that person's vote. In the event such a Certificate is not on file, the vote of such owner shall not be considered.**

If you filled one out before, you do not need to fill out another one. If your voter designation has changed, you will need to submit a new form.
