

## **TRIVIA CORNER**

### **Solar System Facts**

1. The Sun contains 99.8% of the solar system's mass. It's by far the largest object, making it the dominant gravitational force.
2. Jupiter is the largest planet. It's so massive that it could fit all the other planets inside it - with room to spare.
3. Venus is the hottest planet. Despite Mercury being closest to the Sun, Venus's thick



atmosphere traps more heat.

4. Mars has the tallest volcano. Olympus Mons on Mars is about 13.6 miles (22 km) high - almost three times Mount Everest's height.
5. Saturn has the most extensive ring system. Its rings are made of ice, dust, and rock, and extend hundreds of thousands of kilometers.
6. Uranus rotates on its side. Its axial tilt is about 98 degrees, making its seasons extremely unusual.
7. Neptune has the strongest winds. Winds on Neptune can reach speeds over 1,200 mph (2,000 km/h).
8. Earth is the only known planet with life. So far, it's the only place where life is confirmed to exist.
9. Mercury has no atmosphere. Because of its small size and proximity to the Sun, it can't hold a significant atmosphere.
10. The asteroid belt lies between Mars and Jupiter. It contains millions of rocky objects, including the dwarf planet Ceres.





## Family Scams

Scammers are good at **pretending to be someone that they're not**. They try to trick you into thinking **a loved one is in trouble**.

Once the scammer makes you think they're your grandson and in trouble, they pressure you to quickly send them money. **But it's all a scam.**

Your family member was never in trouble.

- The scammer will say it's **urgent** and that you're the only one who can help.
- The scammer might tell you it's **important to keep it secret**. They don't want you talking to other family members and friends and realizing it's a scam.
- The scammers will **play with your emotions**. They're counting on you to act quickly to help your family or friend. And they're counting on you to pay without stopping to check out whether there's really an emergency. If you get a call like this, you can be sure this is a scam.

**Slow down. Verify.**



### Example of a Family Emergency Scam Call

Hi Grandpa, it's me.



Sebastian? Is that you?



Yes, it's me, Sebastian. Grandpa, I'm in trouble, and I need money for bail.


