A Communications Committee Update to the Cove Community

August 2025

The mission of the Communications Committee is to keep the Cove community informed with up-to-date, accurate information concerning current issues and projects.

To all Harbor Cove Residents,

Greetings everyone! We have some updates to share with you. As residents begin contacting me with suggestions or concerns, I will be sharing these items without identifying them by name. I value people contacting our committee and I do not want to cause any discomfort to anyone.

Update #1: the Harbor Cove 2025 Directory

• As you may know, Sue Hansen managed our directories for many years. Since she left, Lori Casiano, our board director, assumed responsibility for completing this task. This morning, Lori reports that all pictures and addresses have been formatted and submitted to the publisher. While a final proof-reading will still need to be done, the target date for the completed directories to arrive in Harbor Cove is the first week of October! Yay – they will soon be here! And a BIG shout-out to Lori for taking on and completing this huge job!

<u>Update #2: a traffic light on 41 in front of our entrance</u>

• A HC resident called and asked me if we could check into getting a traffic light either in front of our entrance or Harbor Isles' to better ensure our safety while going in and out of the park. Since 41 is a county road, this is a Sarasota County decision. Our board liaison, Lori Casiano, is going to meet with Wayne to see if the park has requested this before and/or if something can be done about this now. We will keep you informed however this unfolds so that you know what is happening.

<u>Update #3: the TV Channel 2 is not working</u>

 Lori is looking into this and we will have an update when we know something definite to report.

<u>Update #4: issues concerning landscaping, street repairs, metal/boards in the pond</u>

 Another HC resident called me with concerns about a variety of landscaping issues involving trimming, dead trees/branches, and mangrove trimming. Plus, questions about street repairs, and metal and boards remaining in the ponds after the past hurricanes. The Communications Committee has sent a detailed listing of these concerns to Wayne, our new manager. The good news is that Wayne is VERY interested and knowledgeable about landscaping. But he has had so many "fires" to put out since assuming his role, he is still working to get to our landscaping needs. As we stated in our last report: PLEASE BE PATIENT! All our concerns did not happen overnight, and it will take time to see all our issues resolved.

That is all for now – our committee or Wayne will keep you informed of the latest happenings in Harbor Cove.
