## **Have Your Say on the Basketball Courts!**

As your Board, we want to advocate for what our residents want. Before making any large financial decisions about community basketball courts, we'd love to hear your opinion.

We're considering three options:

- Replace the hoops only with commercial-grade hoops (necessary for liability) - ~\$10,000
- Repair the courts (resurface, fix cracks, repaint lines, etc.) –  $\sim$ \$50,000, with an expected life of 5–10 years
- Completely redo the courts ~\$150,000-\$200,000; may require a special assessment

Do you have the creepiest cobwebs? The spookiest skeletons? The most bewitching front yard in town? Then this contest is for YOU!


