COOKING CORNER

This month I am featuring a high protein chicken dish. It is easy to prepare, and the recipe can easily be reduced to fit the needs of your household.

This chicken entree combines the flavors of pesto, fresh mozzarella cheese, tomato, and parmesan to enhance the taste of chicken.

Serve with rice or pasta (your choice), and a vegetable or salad.

PESTO CHICKEN BAKE

4 chicken breasts, slightly pounded 1/4 cup of pesto sauce (any brand or homemade) 6 slices of fresh mozzarella cheese

6 slices of fresh tomato Italian seasoning to taste Parmesan cheese to taste



Preheat oven to350.

Spray a 9x13x2 inch pan with olive oil.

Place the chicken between 2 sheets of waxed paper or Saran wrap and lightly pound with a meat tenderizer or a rolling pin slightly. Place in pan. Spoon one T. of Pesto sauce all over each chicken breast.

Place 1 1/2 slices of fresh mozzarella on each chicken breast, top with 1 1/2 slices of fresh tomato. Sprinkle with Italian seasoning and Parmesan cheese to taste.

Bake 30-40 minutes, let set for 5 minutes before serving.

Ask any paint specialist at Sherwin Williams what is available for the type of siding you have. They have a color chart for you to look at. 
