The past several years the severe storms have dominated what projects the Beautification Committee has had to work on. From cleaning up the community to repairing fencing in the compound, rebuilding the golf cart path around Imperial Lake and lastly working to restore the clubhouse. It is my hope that we can get a long reprieve from rebuilding and repairing Harbor Cove and move on to other enhancements in the community.



So as October starts the return of many of our snowbird volunteers, it's time to start looking for what projects we will be working on this fall. Some ideas that have already been brought forward, will be to improve the entrance to the community out by

Tamiami Trail and down Blackburn Blvd. As always, we gather volunteers to assist our Maintenance Staff with some landscaping efforts.

With the total rebuild to our marina replacing all of the exterior piers and the floating center dock which is only a couple of years old, we may want to work around the exterior grounds surrounding the marina or even do some work around the pool area.

We may not have the funds to replace the pavilion at this time, but there are still things we can do to improve these areas.

How this group works is we either pick a project or get assigned one and then we put a notice out requesting volunteers to get the project completed. Many times I look for someone besides myself to head up the task. We always try to list details of what is required, ie. special talents needed, tools required and approximate time commitment.

The membership changes depending on the project that is put in front of us. We still take requests from residents that need help with something around their house, so if that is something you are looking for please let me know. We passed the house of the month to the Civic group.

So, if you are new to the Harbor Cove Community or a seasoned veteran, if you are willing to get involved, this is a great group to join. Generally, the time commitment is minimal, we work hard but have a lot of fun in the process.

I hope this helps clarify the Beautification Committee.





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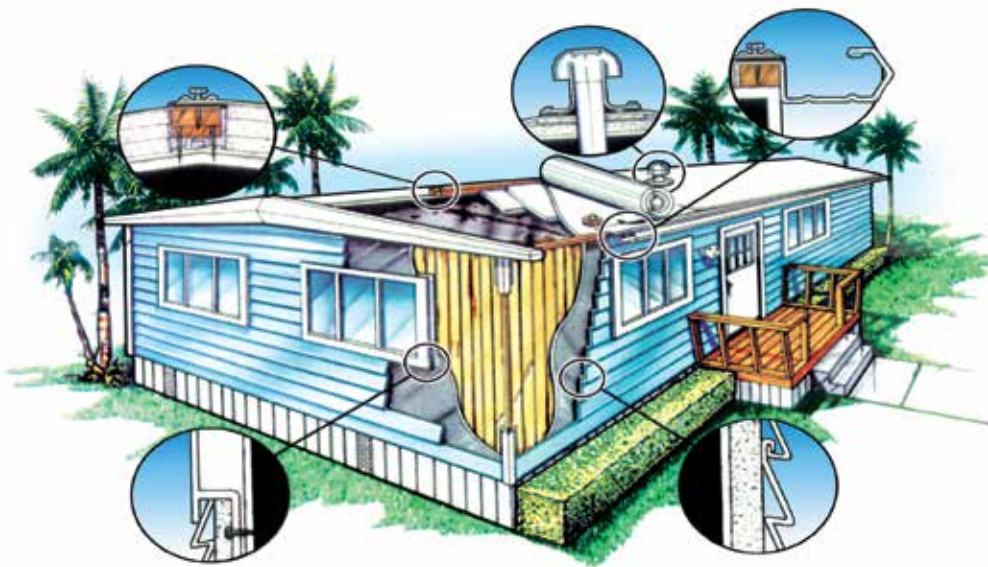
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Harbor Cove Communications Committee Update

6. UPDATE on damaged homes being removed: Some homes have been demolished and removed from the park during the summer months. More detailed information will be coming by November after Communications Committee members return to the park and are able to do a visual drive-through report. Thank you for your patience!

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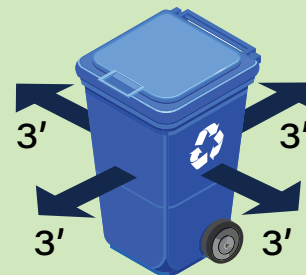

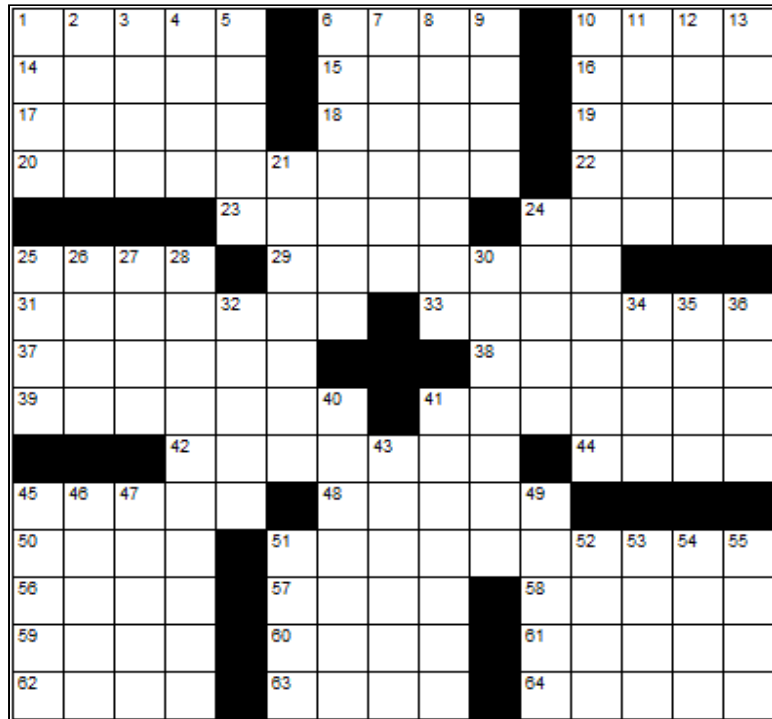

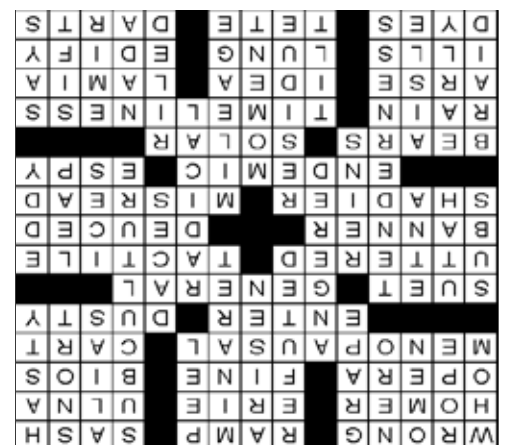
