

Are you prepared?

Key hurricane preparedness tips from Sarasota County's Emergency Services
As storm season approaches, take these steps to protect your home:

- Secure loose rain gutters and downspouts, and clear clogged areas or debris.
- Secure and reinforce your roof, windows and doors, including garage doors.
- Consider building a FEMA safe room designed for protection from high winds and flood waters.
- Learn how to turn off gas, water, electricity.

Checklist for Sheltering in Place

- Fill bathtub or other large containers with water.
- Drinking water, one gallon per person, per day, for at least three days.
- Canned food, a can opener and paper items
- Medications, prescriptions and a first aid kit.
- Battery-operated television or radio, flashlight and extra batteries.
- Cash (ATMs may be out-of-service).
- Pet supplies.
- Photocopies of important documents (birth certificate, license and insurance).
- Full tank of gas in car.

Heather Villalba has been part of food prep at SVCA. Now she is sharing some of her secrets!

Pumpkin Earthquake Cake Pumpkin Spice & Everything Nice!

Fall is the perfect time for cozy baking and pumpkin season is here. Some of my favorite fall memories are in the kitchen, when the air outside turned crisp and the whole house smelled like cinnamon and pumpkin.

The kids loved helping with this Pumpkin Earthquake Cake—mostly because of the name. They'd giggle and peek through the oven door, waiting to see the "cracks" form on top as it baked. By the time it came out, swirls of sweetened cream cheese, warm spiced pumpkin, and gooey melted chocolate were bubbling up, and everyone was ready for a treat.

It's rich, cozy, and a little indulgent—the kind of dessert that feels like home. Around here, it never lasts long, especially with a scoop of vanilla ice cream or a dollop of whipped cream on top. If you're ready for a fun twist on the classic pumpkin pie, this Pumpkin Earthquake Cake is a must-try.

Ingredients

Cake Batter:

- 1 box spice cake mix
- 3 large eggs
- 1 cup pumpkin puree (pure pumpkin canned - not pumpkin pie mix)
- 3/4 cup water
- 1/2 cup vegetable oil
- 1/3 cup granulated sug-
- 2 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice

Cream Cheese Filling:

- 8 ounces cream cheese (room temperature)
- 1/2 cup unsalted butter (melted)
- 3 cups powdered sugar
 1/2 cup chocolate chips

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray a 9x13 baking pan with non-stick spray.
- 2. In a large bowl, mix together the cake mix, pumpkin, eggs, water, oil, sugar and pumpkin pie spice.

Mary will tell us about managing local ecosystems that help protect the Myakka River and source of water supply. Meet at the first parking lot on the right.

Monday, October 20, 9:00 to 11:00am. Dr. Mary Davis leads a guided walk at the Manasota Scrub Preserve, 2695 Bridge St., Englewood. - 3. Pour batter into the prepared pan.
- 4. In another bowl, mix melted butter with room temperature cream cheese.
- 5. Stir in the powdered sugar and mix until well combined.
- 6. Place spoonfuls of the cream cheese mixture all over the top of the cake mixture. Using a knife, gently swirl through the cream cheese.
- 7. Sprinkle chocolate chips on top.
- 8. Bake for 40-50 minutes or until center is set.
- Allow the cake to almost completely cool before cutting. If you cut before it cools, the cake will be very soft and won't cut cleanly.
- 10. Serve with vanilla ice cream or whipped cream.
- 11. Store in an airtight container in the refrigerator.
